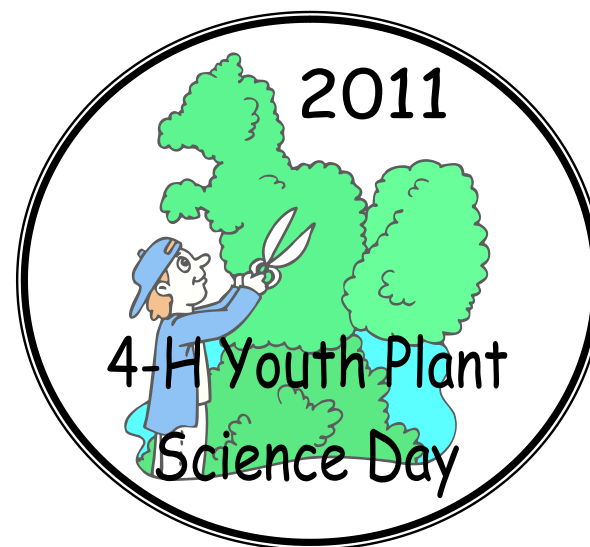

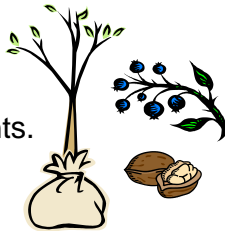
2011 Youth Plant Science Day

In the morning, regular participants will:

- ☼ Identify fruits, nuts, vegetables, trees, shrubs, flowers, and houseplants.
- ☼ Judge and place classes of plants. (As done at local County Fairs.)
- ☼ Test your knowledge with a written horticulture test.

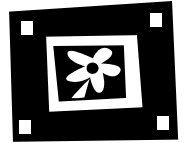


- ☼ “Floral Design - Tricks of the Trade”

☼ Photography:

Digital- The digital is open to anyone age 12 – 22. Four categories – single unedited; single slightly edited; single heavily edited & sequence of 4 to 8 digital images that tell a visual story without the use of words.



35 mm-The 35 mm is open to anyone age 8 – 22. The categories for that are single B & W; Single Color; Sequence of 4; Horticulture collection of B & W or color photos that tell a story without the use of words.
