The 2012 Art Lab Tracks

- **Choreography for Musical Theatre** - - Join 4-H Showcase Singers Alumnus's Tyler and Nettie Schimke as they show you some the best show choir choreography around! Create your own choreography too!
- **Basketry** - Taught by veteran basket-maker and Lincoln County 4-H Staff member Amanda Kostman, you'll be sure to bring some awesome baskets home after this session!
- **Photography** - Join the State 4-H Photo Team Director Marybeth Seib and Assistant Director Aaron Brown for some real hands-on photography!
- **Directing for the Theatre** - Jay Johnson, our State 4-H Drama Company Director and Pat Henderson, our Assistant Drama Company Director will help you create and stage a variety of exciting scenes for the theatre. You might learn some great theatre games too!
- **Fiber Art** - Join Washburn County 4-H Agent, Annette Haas, as she shares her awesome skills as a fiber artist! You'll learn about different fibers, make yarn, dye yarn, and work with yarn.
- **Oil Painting** - Taught by oil painter extraordinaire and 4-H leader Dan Rizzi, this session will get you up and painting in no time!
- **Video Production & Editing** - Make your own movies and share them with the world! Taught by 4-H leader, and pretty good film maker too, Rick Snyder.
- **Tae Kwon Do** - Join the experienced and super-fun 4-H leader, Mary Lubner for some real hands on learning with an ancient art form!
- **Altered Books** – Magically transform an old book into a work of art! We'll paint, photo collage, cut, stitch and embellish to create an altered book that goes beyond scrap booking!(So bring some of those favorite photos and let your imagination run wild!) Taught by local artist and 4-H volunteer Sue Wendlandt.
- **Duct Tape Art** - What can you make out of duct tape? Are you kidding! Just about anything! Join duct tape maestro Rosie Bermudez as she helps you create the duct tape artwork of your dreams! Cell phone cases, CD cases, clothing, wallets, hats.....you name it, and we'll help you make it!
- **Jewelry!** - Would you like to learn how to make your own jewelry? Well—here's your chance. Learn the basic steps of simple beading by making your own one-of-a-kind beaded bracelet made of safety pins! You will learn how to string, clamp, and add clasp your own work. Take home your creation and wear it proudly! Taught by jewelry artist maestro Jo Woodcock.
- **Foil Repousse** - Participants will design and create realistic 3-d impressions on copper and aluminum sheets that may be tinted with color and then framed. The design will incorporate the theme "under the sea" and participants will base their designs on fish, turtles and coral. Taught by artist Tim Woodcock.
