ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must be an active member, or alumni, of the Wisconsin 4-H Horse or Horseless Horse Project.
Applicant must be a student currently enrolled in or accepted at a two or four-year post high school educational institution.
Once you have been awarded a Wisconsin 4-H Horse Association \$500 scholarship, you cease to be eligible.

WISCONSIN 4-H HORSE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Wisconsin 4-H Horse Association will be awarding several \$500 scholarships. Anyone who is, or has been, a 4-H member, and is enrolled, or plans to enroll, in a university, college, or technical school during the next school year is eligible to apply. Application forms are available from your county UW-Extension office. **The deadline for submission of your application is August 15.**

In addition, a \$100 scholarship for the high senior youth in each of the following individual educational contests at State Expo will be awarded:

- Hippology
- Public Speaking
- Demonstration
- Judging Contest (with reasons)
- Horse Bowl

Youth are eligible to earn **ONE** scholarship in each division and may hold the certificate until successful completion of their first semester of post-high school education.
