

2011 State 4-H Hippology Contest
May 7, 2011
UW-Marathon County Campus

Contest will run at the same time as Horse Bowl with Senior contestants first completing the Hippology Event if desired to compete. Beginners and Juniors will complete the Hippology Contest as soon as their teams are finished with Horse Bowl when all Seniors have completed the contest.

Hippology contest will take place with no pre-entry

The cost is \$5 per youth.- payable at the event.

Divisions: Beginner 3-5, Junior 6-8, Senior 9-13.

This is an educational activity of five or more horse related areas. Contestants are given a score sheet and two minutes at each station to complete their answers. (A short written exam is required in the senior division.)

The Grand and Reserve county senior teams may be eligible for Regional and National contests. One additional state team may be eligible for the Regional contest.

Counties do not enter as a Hippology Team – as the team to go on will be the top individual from the county.

The State team members do not need to pre-enter as a team (Senior contestants must compete in the judging contest at Expo to be considered for Regional or National Hippology contests.)
