

Wisconsin Qualifying Requirements/Events for the 4-H National Invitational Shoot

Listed below are the minimum number of scores needed to qualify in each discipline and which shoots you can earn qualifying scores. If you earn more than the minimum number of scores in a discipline, your highest scores will be used. You can earn multiple qualifying scores per shoot, but only one qualifying score per discipline. Example: if you shoot in three archery target events at Shawano, only the highest score will count as a qualifying target score. However, you can qualify a target, animal and FITA score at the same shoot along with a shotgun, air rifle or other score. Archery Recurve lists *'ed shoots. These shoots have Archery Limited and Archery Barebow events in which both recurve and compounds can be used. If a recurve is used, it must be noted while registering so it can be used as a qualifying Recurve score. National Age Requirement: Participants must have passed their 14th birthday and not have passed their 19th birthday by January 1st of the year of the National. Participants who qualify are eligible to attend National the year following qualification.

This will provide a complete list of scheduled shoots offering National 4-H Invitational qualification opportunities. Should the number of events be reduced for any given year, the number of required shoots for qualification may also be reduced. The maximum number of required scores will not exceed three for any discipline.
