Using documentaries this class will look at some of the most noteworthy struggles of workers in the United States and internationally to improve their conditions in the recent past.

- **Union Town** - Tom Morello sings about his time in Madison
- **Mother Jones: America's Most Dangerous Woman** – and our greatest union organizer!
- **Harvest of Loneliness, The Bracero Program** – the temporary contract labor program (1942-1964) and how it undermined farm worker unionization
- **Global Village or Global Pillage**- how the corporate global economy is set up and functioning
- **Made In Thailand** – workers organizing in Thailand and America's Triangle Fire
- **Eye of the Storm** - longshoremen's successful struggle against their employers and the Bush Administration
- **Locked Out** - miners' victorious fight against Rio Tinto, an international mega-mining corporation
- **A Class Apart** - From a small-town Texas murder emerged a landmark civil rights case. The little-known story of the Mexican American lawyers who took the discrimination case Hernandez v. Texas to the Supreme Court.
- **Letters from the Other Side** - a portrait of families torn apart by economics, communities dying at the hands of globalization, and governments incapable or unwilling to do anything about it.
