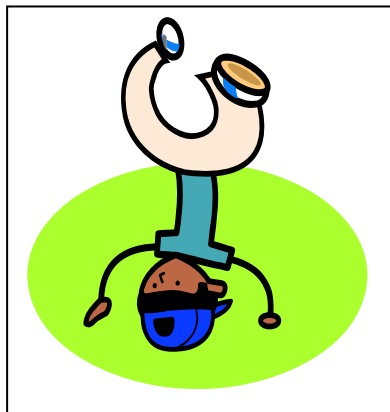
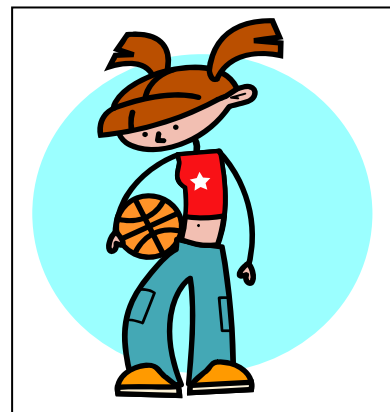


# Working with those Wonderful and Challenging School-Aged Children in your Programs
