

# Pete's a Pizza Skillathon Poster Text

## SITUATION:

Your second graders need to be encouraged to read more and communicate with others.

YOUR TASK is to facilitate Pete's a Pizza

### Read Pete's a Pizza Activity

1. Encourage youth to discuss and predict throughout the story
2. Discuss "bad" moods and what kids do to cheer up when they are in a bad mood.

### Brainstorm About Pizza

1. Ask youth to describe different kinds of pizza and how it
  - o Tastes
  - o Looks
  - o Smells
  - o Feels.

### Pointillism Art Activity [Individual dots that make up a whole picture]

1. Helper uses a black crayon to draw a large circle on the rough side of a sheet of sandpaper to represent a pizza.
2. Youth color in their pizza by pressing hard and coloring all the space.
3. Helper does the ironing part of this activity away from the kids.

## TALK IT OVER

### Reflect

- What new pizza toppings did you learn about today?
- Which toppings did you draw on your pizza slice?

### Apply

- Next time you go out for pizza, what new topping will you try?

### Enhance by asking older youth:

Pointillism art uses dots to make up the whole picture. Look at your pizza art after it was ironed onto the paper.

- How is your iron on pizza art like Pointillism Art?
- How is it different?
