

# Listening for Sounds Skillathon Poster Text

## SITUATION:

Listening is part of our everyday life. This lesson will help children learn to listen to different sounds and realize the need to pay close attention.

YOUR TASK is to play SOUND BINGO

## Sound Bingo Activity

Practice listening by playing sound bingo.

1. Give each child an envelope with pictures of things that make sounds.
2. Have them place one picture in each square of the sound bingo card. Any picture may go in any square.
3. Pass out space markers
4. Children take turns drawing one picture out of the paper bag at a time, make the sound and all children who have that picture on their card will cover it with a marker

NOTE: The game is played like bingo. Use prizes if you wish.

- How did the sound bingo game help us practice listening?
- What happened if you did not listen carefully to the sound?

### Apply

- How would a person communicate if they could not hear?
- What can we do to be a good listener?
