As a result of these reviews, documents submitted by John DeMontmollin, Demetrius Brown, and Joan Wimme were sent on to be reviewed by FTAC and have since gone on to be reviewed by the dean and chancellor, ultimately to be reviewed by the Board of Regents. The document submitted by Matthew Calvert was reviewed in April and will be submitted to FTAC for consideration at their Fall, 2009 meeting.

Mini Portfolios: Mini portfolios were submitted by Jill Jorgenson, Doug Liphart, Amy Mitchell, and Dean Slark.
