The committee met face to face July 27, 2010, September 22, 2010, November 23, 2010, January 25 and 26 and by wisline August 19, 2010.

Portfolio Reviews for Tenure: As a result of the review process, documents submitted by Kevin Palmer, Colleen Pulvermacher, Doug Liphart, and Mary Pardee were forwarded to FTAC.

Portfolio Review Process: The committee continued to work with the revised form developed and review format agreed upon at the beginning of the year. A discussion about the pros and cons of electronic portfolio documents will begin at the department meeting in April with suggestions to be forwarded to the SRP Committee for their review.

Mini Portfolios: Mini-portfolio documents were due to committee members February 10, 2011. Mini-portfolio reviews will be conducted by SRP members prior to May 1, 2011. Mini portfolio documents were submitted by Jackie Johnson, Chris Viau, Judy Wolniakowski, Gail Roberts, and Maria Habib. These documents will be reviewed by committee members and comments will be shared with the faculty members at the time of the review.

Tenure Orientation: The committee sponsored a Tenure Orientation Workshop on January 26, 2011 attended by 38 people including presenters and committee members. The SRP Committee revised the workshop format, offering 2 tracks 1) early career 2) later career. Participant evaluations indicate a desire to see continued tracking for the workshop in the future. The committee will use program evaluation comments to plan the 2012 Tenure Orientation Workshop.
