**DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION IS MARCH 14, 2012**

### **WHAT WE DO FUND**

The Wisconsin 4-H Learning Resources Committee Awards program provides funding primarily in support of the development of learning resources to enhance 4-H programs in Wisconsin. Available funds will be used to support innovative projects focused on 4-H Learning Resources.

The Wisconsin 4-H Learning Resources Committee will give highest priority to program funding applications that include one or more of the following components:

- Creates new 4-H learning resources to support new and existing 4-H projects
- Utilizes 4-H learning resources to expand 4-H programming to diverse audiences
- Develops training resources for staff and/or 4-H project leaders
- Adapts emerging technology for youth, staff and/or 4-H project leaders
- Is a multi-county application and/or one that will serve a larger audience and can be easily replicated in other counties

### **WHAT WE DON'T FUND**

- Cash awards.
- Paying volunteer leaders or 4-H staff for services.
- Building projects or facility improvements

### **HOW TO APPLY**

- All program funding applications must be typed or word processed using the application form and signed by a county and/or state 4-H staff person.
