Camp will include a variety of activities

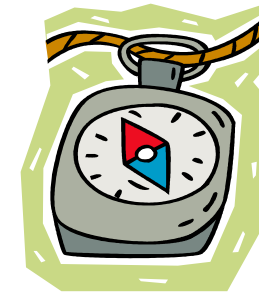
- Swimming
