Japan Nihongo Intensive Language Program	June 10 - July 7	12-18	\$5,150 (\$900 for language program and \$4,250 for month-long program)	Delegates participating in the Nihongo program stay in Tokyo for 3 weeks of language instruction, then move to a new host family for the month-long program (see above)

Australian Exchange Network	June 16 - July 15	16-18	\$4,800-\$5,300 Depending on Airfare	Stay with a rural host family in the state of Victoria, Australia

- **Cost Offset:** All International Program delegates are required to earn at least \$1,000 of the costs through fundraising. Host scholarships available through the Japanese Exchange. One \$500 state scholarship is available; other national scholarships may become available.
- **Orientation:** All outbound participants are *required* to attend Orientation at Upham Woods the first weekend of March and Re-Entry Workshop in August.
- **Adult Leaders:** Must be over 21 and must complete the Wisconsin 4-H Youth Protection Program. Program fees are partially covered for each program. They will be assigned one or two host families.
