

# Wisconsin Junior Olympic Championship

## Air Rifle

### March 24 or 25, 2007

1. Shooting times will be assigned by the area coordinator. We anticipate three or more locations spaced around Wisconsin. Contact Allan Pribnow for locations. Relay times will be set up by cooperating local clubs. Teams may shoot on either March 24 or March 25.
2. Conduct of the qualifying competition is the responsibility of the State 4-H Junior Olympic Coordinator, Allan Pribnow.
3. The course of fire is 3 X 20 ( 20 shots prone, 20 shots standing, and 20 shots kneeling, fired in that order)
4. Eligibility: Any student (no minimum age) currently enrolled in elementary, middle, high school or its equivalent educational program, (including home schooling). This is a team event. Teams will consist of 4 individuals who shoot as a team. Team must maintain team integrity. Teams must be made up of individuals from the same school or club.
5. Membership in any organization is not required.
6. Rules. National Standard Three-Position 5th edition will apply.
7. Every group MUST have a Naturespace competition. The sponsoring group will set rules and awards.
8. Assisting groups may add awards at their discretion and expense. ( I. E. individual awards for high score in age groups, Naturespace etc.).
9. Event 1, Awards: The top three teams in precision and the top three teams in sporter class, regardless of age will receive state medals. Teams will only be awarded one set of medals.
10. Event 2, Awards: The top three teams in Senior sporter class will receive medals. The team must consist of members that are aged 15 - 19
11. Event 3, Awards: The top three teams in the Intermediate sporter class will receive medals. The team must consist of team members that are aged 12 - 14.

12. Event 3. Awards: The top three teams in the Junior sporter class will receive medals. The team must consist of team members that are aged 8 - 11.
13. There are no individual prizes for any class.
14. This is a USA Shooting Sanctioned Match and State Records will be made and kept.
15. Registration and Fees. Entry fees will be \$10.00 per person. Each team will consist of 4 shooters and a coach. Each team will shoot in a sporter or precision class. No team will shoot in more than one class.
16. The top team in precision class and the top team in sporter class will represent Wisconsin in the National Junior Olympics held at Bowling Green, Kentucky. If the winning teams cannot for any reason go to Bowling Green, the second place team may go. Wisconsin teams will be given information on their trip to Bowling Green. The sporter team will shoot in early July. Precision team will also shoot in early July.
17. Results. All participating Coaches will be notified of their team's final scores and standings by mail within 10 days after April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Wisconsin State Teams will be given required information and some financial assistance in equipment for their trip to Kentucky.
