Art Team is a leadership experience for youth leaders eager to learn more about leadership in the visual arts and crafts. On the Art Team you work with a professional artist on the design for a large public art piece and plan the Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference Art Exhibit (works of 4-H members from throughout the state) at the UW-Madison campus conference site. This gives you a chance to learn about setting up displays, evaluating artwork, and explaining art to visitors. You will go behind-the-scenes for tours of local museums, interview curators to learn about museum careers and participate in several other art-related experiences. You will lead a Youth Conference session teaching Conference youth delegates how to lead art activities in their clubs.
