## ACTORS

**Job Description:** Actors are 4-H members interested in being onstage for productions. Actors develop and act out the script in conjunction with other members of the Drama Company. Actors may also assist with technical aspects of the production.

Actors are individuals interested in working hard and putting on the best performance possible. They are not interested in drawing attention to themselves, but are there for the best interests of the team and the production.

## TECHNICIANS

**Job Description:** Technicians are 4-H members with a sincere interest in scene design, construction, lighting, and sound. Technicians learn how effects are developed and the importance of technical elements to the production.

Technicians are individuals who are innovative, responsible, eager to learn, cooperative, reliable, and capable of working on tasks on their own without constant supervision.

## SEMINAR COORDINATORS

**Job Description:** Seminar Coordinators are 4-H members who are responsible for planning workshops for Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference. Past seminars included: "Talking it over with the Drama Company" and "Getting into the Act." Tasks will be supervised and coordinated in conjunction with the director and adult team members.

Coordinators are expected to use the Theatre Arts Adventures Curriculum and other resources in planning seminar choices.

## ASSISTANTS TO THE DIRECTOR

**Job Description:** Assistants to the Director (AD's) are 4-H members who have participated in Drama Companies in the past and have demonstrated leadership abilities. AD's learn about directing, acting, coordination, and group management skills.

AD's are responsible for taking notes during rehearsals, leading select training and warm up activities and are actively involved in assisting in the coordination of all aspects of the Drama Company's work.
