Art Team is a leadership experience for youth leaders eager to learn more about leadership in the visual arts and crafts. As a member of the Art Team, you plan the Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference Art Exhibit (artwork of 4-H members from throughout the state) at the UW-Madison campus conference site as well as participate in the Youth Exhibit at the Wisconsin State Fair. This gives you a chance to learn about setting up displays, evaluating artwork, and explaining art to visitors. You will go behind-the-scenes for tours of local museums, interview curators to learn about museum careers and participate in several other art-related experiences. You will lead a Youth Conference session teaching Conference youth delegates how to lead art activities in their clubs.

- Able to attend Planning Weekend for Art/Drama/Showcase, April 18-19, 2008, at Upham Woods
- Able to attend Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference, June 12-19, 2008, at UW-Madison
- Able to attend Wisconsin State Fair, July 30-August 5, 2008 at State Fair Park
