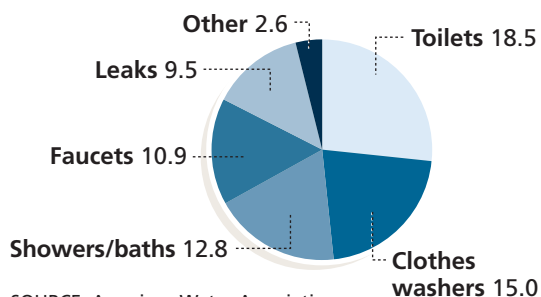


Drip, drip, drip...

According to the American Water Association, water leaks waste 9.5 gallons per capita per day in the typical single family home. That equals 23.5 gallons per household, or over 8,500 per year — enough water to supply a typical single family home with indoor water for 50 days.
