

Articles of Incorporation

The undersigned incorporator(s), natural persons 18 years of age or older, in order to form a corporate entity adopts the following articles of incorporation.

Article I. Name/Registered Office

The name of this corporation shall be *Advanced Leadership Program of Juneau County* located at 211 Hickory Street, Mauston, WI 53948.

Article II. Purpose.

This incorporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, more specifically to develop a leadership program that creates a pool of citizenry empowered with the ability to facilitate change in a positive proactive manner for the benefit of Juneau County.

Article III Exemption Requirements

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

1. The corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise to its Board of Directors. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member of the Board of Directors of this corporation, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes. Such net earnings, if any, of this corporation shall be used to carry out the nonprofit corporation purposes set forth in Article II above.

2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.

Article IV. Duration

The duration of the corporate existence shall be perpetual.

Article V. Membership/Board of Directors

The corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation. The number of Directors constituting the first Board of Directors is 17, their names and addresses being as follows:
