

4-H POULTRY JUDGING CONTEST

The Poultry Judging Contest is a team contest. Teams of 3 or 4 youth will compete. Classes will include egg production hens, eggs, and market poultry. The contest will be very similar to the national contest format. More information on this contest can be found at:

Questions will be used in lieu of oral reasons. Not all classes from the national contest may be represented at the state event.

In 2008, this contest will be conducted on **July 12**, at the Poultry Research Lab on the UW Campus in Madison, WI. **Contest will begin at 9 am.**

Participants must be 4-H members.

There will be both a junior (under 14 yr) and senior (14-18 yr) division. The senior division winner will represent the State of Wisconsin at the 4-H National Poultry & Egg Conference held in Louisville, KY.

All classes will be set up in accordance with the Rules and Standards printed in the National Poultry Judging Manual, "University of Nebraska Cooperative Extension 4-H 460" 2002 revised edition.
