June 7 and 8, 2008 - Jefferson, Wisconsin

ENTRY DEADLINE: June 1, 2008

ELIGIBILITY:

Must be between the ages of 8-19 as of January 1, 2008. Must be a Wisconsin resident.

Exception: If a breed association sponsors a Preview Show in conjunction with the WLBA Preview Show, their junior association out-of-state members and members that fall within their association's age limits are allowed to exhibit - only in classes co-sponsored by that breed association.

SCHEDULE:

Saturday, June 7th - Sheep & Cattle in place by 7:30 AM

7-8 AM - Livestock check-in

8:15 AM - Sheep Show

8:15 AM - Beef Show

Sunday, June 8th - 7 AM - Pig weigh-in

8:30 AM - Show

GENERAL RULES:

All animals are to be fed, fitted, entered, and shown by the exhibitor. Family members and other junior exhibitors are allowed to help.

Exhibitors must show their own animals. In case of an emergency, another junior exhibitor may show said animals upon prior consent of the Species Chairman and the Executive Director.

Registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor or in his/her parents or farm name. To be eligible for Bred and Owned competition, the breeder and the owner of the animal must be in the exhibitor's name only. Any animal entered in a WLBA Livestock Show must be shown by the same exhibitor for the current show season.

An exhibitor may enter animals in any two species. There will be no re-weighing of market animals.

Materials may not be used to change the color of an animal. If natural color is altered, that animal is disqualified. There will be no painting on sheep to either alter or enhance color.

No medicines can be given an animal at the show without a vet's or Species Chairman approval. Blood or urine tests may be taken if a complaint is filed regarding irregular use of drugs. If the tests are positive, the exhibitor stands any costs incurred in testing and will be banned from future WLBA Junior Show participation.

Any animal that has been altered through surgical procedures will be disqualified and the exhibitor's status at future shows will be determined by the show committee.

There will be no smoking in the barns or use of controlled substances or alcohol on the grounds by either exhibitors or adults.

Interpretation of any rule infraction rests with the show committee which has the authority to bar a person from exhibiting at this show or other WLBA Shows. The Executive Director will serve in an advisory position on any rule infraction.

Sheep pens will be assigned. Please check in with the Species Chairman before unloading.

All pens, stalls, and fitting areas must be cleaned thoroughly before exhibitors leave. A clean-up charge will be assessed to violators.

SHOWMANSHIP:

Showmanship shall be according to the following age breakdowns as of January 1, 2008:

8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15, 16-19

BEEF:

Exhibitors may show up to 5 heifers and 3 steers. Heifers must be born after September 1, 2006. Steers must be born after January 1, 2007. Heifers must be purchased by May 1, 2008. Heifers without papers, Crossbred heifers, or lower percentage heifers will be shown as a Commercial Breed. An exhibitor may exhibit one managerial heifer upon filing appropriate paperwork. Purebred heifers must be 75% or more purebred and must carry an ear tattoo

corresponding to the registration papers. Heifers will be shown by breed with classes determined after all heifers have been checked in. Exhibitors may also enter cow/calf pairs. Steers must carry a state or county fair tag. Steers will be shown by breed and weight. Purebred Angus and Hereford steers need registration papers in the exhibitors name. If there are less than 5 steers in one breed, that breed will show in Any Other Breeds. No dairy steers will be shown. In case of a question on a steer's breed purity, the steer will be blood tested at the expense of the person questioning the purity. The testing expense will be refunded if the complaint is proved correct. No steers with horns longer than 1" from the hair line will show. Loosely attached scurs are permitted to show.

SWINE:

Barrows and gilts are eligible for entry. There will be only a prospect pig division. There are no minimum numbers or pre-identification requirements. Pigs will be shown by weight, in either the Purebred or Crossbred Divisions. Registration papers are required for the Purebred Division. All pigs need on the farm veterinary inspection papers. Maximum weight for pigs is 220#.

SHEEP:

Exhibitors may show 4 ewes, 3 rams, 3 market lambs, and 2 feeder lambs of each breed they are showing. Crossbred lambs are considered a breed. Exhibitors must provide registration papers on breeding sheep. All sheep must carry an ear tag corresponding to the registration papers. Ewes without proper papers and Crossbred ewes will show as a Commercial and/or a wether type ewe. Rams without proper papers will not show. Ewes, rams, and lambs must be purchased by May 1, 2008. Exhibitors are allowed to enter one animal in each class of breeding sheep.

Market Lamb Classes: Lambs must be born after January 1, 2008. Lambs will be shown by breed and weight. If there are less than 5 lambs in one breed, that breed will show as Any Other Breeds. No patch shearing will be allowed on lambs. Lambs must not have more than one-half inch of wool. No tubes or blankets allowed on lambs during weigh-in. There will be market and prospect divisions. Divisions will be split at 100#. One time over the scale. Weight and breed determination final.

Ewe Classes: Ewes must be born after September 1, 2006. Spring Lambs: Born on or after Feb. 16, 2008. Winter Lambs: Born between Jan. 1 and Feb. 15, 2008. Fall Lambs: Born between Sept. 1 and Dec. 31, 2007.

Ram Classes: Same as ewe classes.

Sheep showing symptoms of any contagious disease will not be permitted to show. All female and sexually intact males need scrapies tags. There are no drenching and no muzzles rules in force.

Lead Class: Open to all exhibitors. Ewes or wethers may be used in this class. A Lead Class animal must be owned by the immediate family. Entrants shall wear attire made of wool fabrics. The class shall be judged on percentages as follows: 40% on attire of exhibitor, 30% on sheep and how it is handled, 30% on personality and showmanship of exhibitor. Entrants shall provide the sheep chairman with a Lead Class Entry Form no later than check-in-time.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE:

Three master Stockman Awards will be presented at this show - one in each species. Each carries a \$100 cash award and the opportunity to compete at the state level for a \$1,000.00 scholarship. To be eligible for the Master Stockman Award, the applicant must be an exhibitor at a WLBA Show for the past 3 years.

Any exhibitor making a late entry after the closing entry deadline or not paying entry fees prior to the show will pay a double entry fee per animal.
