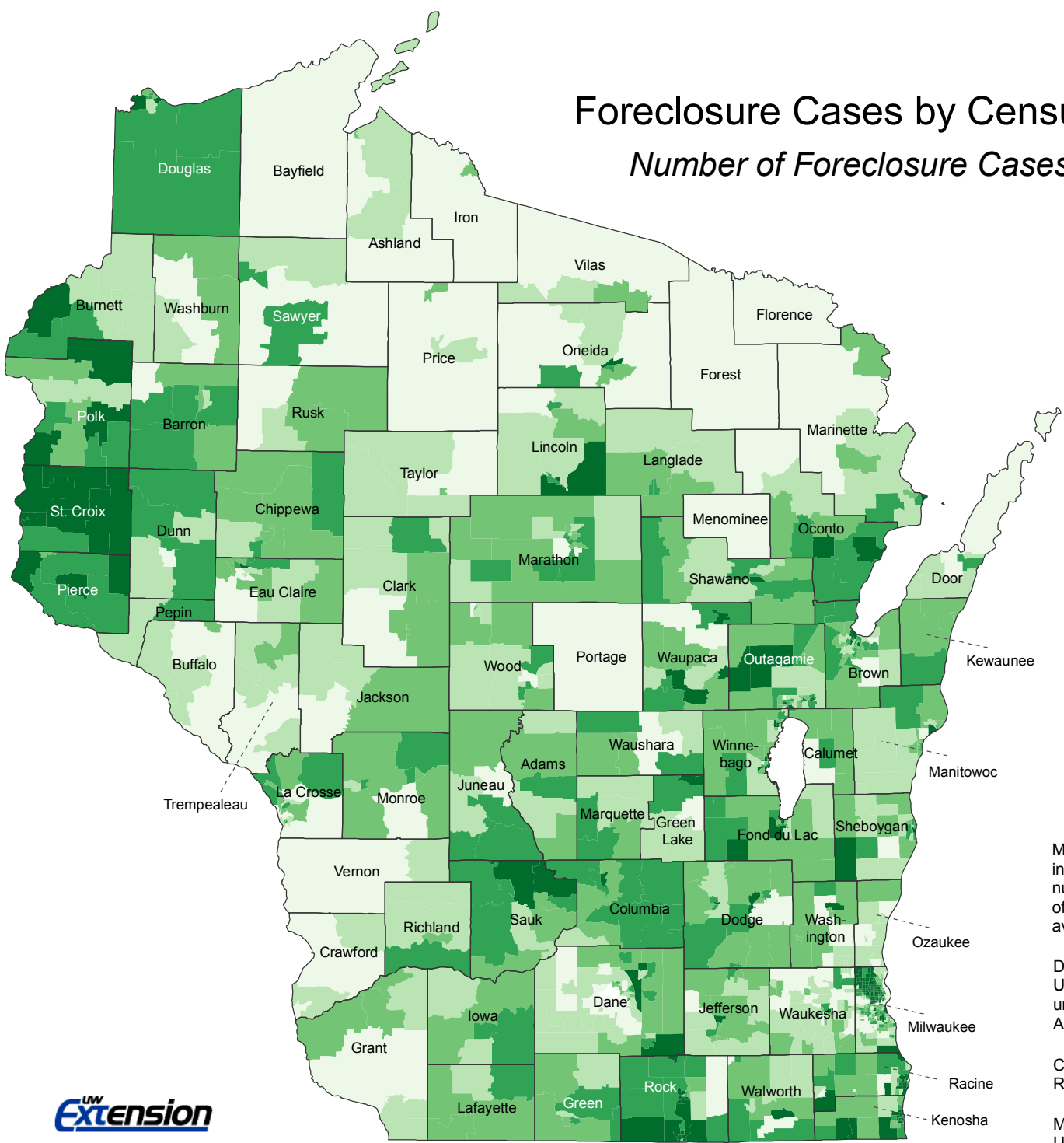


# Foreclosure Cases by Census Tract - 2005 to 2007

## Number of Foreclosure Cases per 100 Housing Units



### Number of Foreclosure Cases per 100 Housing Units (by Census Tract)

- 1st Quantile (0.9 or Less)
- 2nd Quantile (1.0 to 1.4)
- 3rd Quantile (1.5 to 1.9)
- 4th (Quantile 2.0 to 2.7)
- 5th Quantile (2.8 to 10.3)

Mapping by quantiles divides Wisconsin's census tracts into equal categories with each category having the same number of units. Each quantile has approximately 20 percent of Wisconsin's census tracts (~265 census tracts). The state average is 1.8 foreclosure cases per 100 housing units.
