Computer, health-care occupations dominate fastest-growing jobs

Estimated growth in number of jobs in south-central Wisconsin between 2004 and 2014:*

Occupation	Number of new jobs	Growth
Network systems/data communications analysts	310	57%
Home health aides	1,190	53%
Physicians assistants	100	53%
Computer software engineers — applications	930	52%
Computer software engineers — systems software	270	47%
Medical assistants	400	45%
