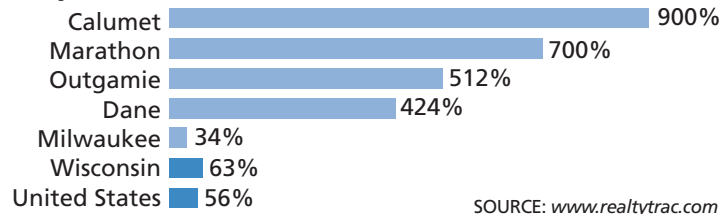


Foreclosure filings up more than 400 percent in Dane County

There were a total of 440 foreclosure filings — default notices, auction sale notices and bank repossessions — during the first six months of 2007 in Dane County. That represents a 424 percent increase over the first six months of 2006 (84 foreclosure filings). Only three counties in Wisconsin had a higher rate of growth
