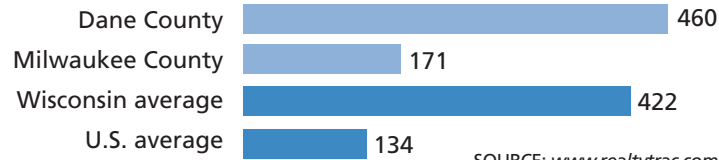


# Foreclosure filings still well below the national average

*In the first half of 2007, few Wisconsin counties even approached the national average of one foreclosure filing per 134 households. Although there has been rapid growth in the number of foreclosure filings (default notices, auction sale notices and bank repossessions), there were 460 households per foreclosure in Dane County. A high number of households per foreclosure means there were fewer foreclosures in that area.*
