Programming Areas

- Wildlife damage management - Homeowners, farmers, property managers all need help reducing losses/damage caused by wildlife.
- Wildlife management on private lands - Private landowners control about 2/3 of the Wisconsin landscape. Their land use/management decisions are critical to wildlife habitat.
- Wildlife-based recreation - Hunting, bird watching, feeding wildlife are all economically important to Wisconsin and our quality of life.
- Youth education - Children develop attitudes toward wildlife at an early age. Education programs shape their future interactions with wildlife.
