Owners and employees of any farm operation that handles and applies liquid or semi-solid manure.

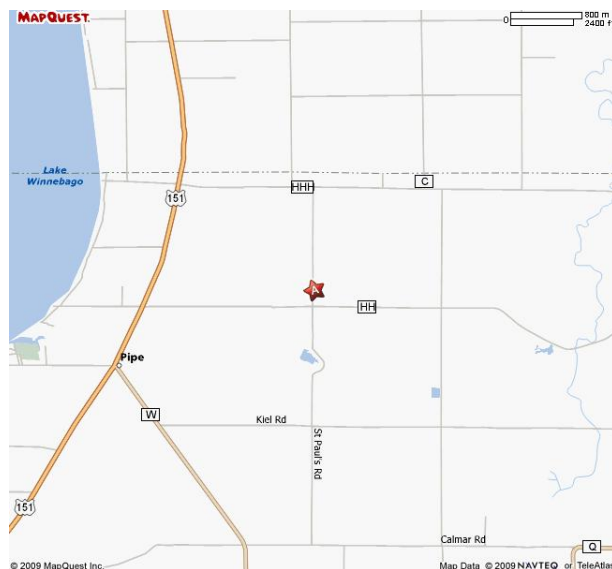
Location:

The demonstration site is located at N10601 St. Paul Rd. This is a wind turbine access road located about a quarter mile north of Hwy. HH. See map below:

Due to construction (from Peebles to the north county line) of Hwy. 151 in Fond du Lac County, alternative routes to the site are as follows:

From the north on 151: Turn left on Indian Rd. (north of Calumetville) then right on S. Tower Rd. to Hwy. HHH. Turn left (east) on HHH and then first right on St. Paul Rd. Proceed south to site.

From the south on 151: At Peebles, take Hwy. WH to St. Peter, then north on Hwy. QQ to Hwy. Q. Go right on Hwy. Q to Johnsburg, then north on Hwy. W to Calmar Rd (first right). Turn right on Calmar Rd. then first left onto St. Paul Rd. Proceed north across Hwy. HH to site.
