CALL FOR PAPERS- ABSTRACTS DUE BY JANUARY 15, 2012

We are soliciting abstracts for both Friday afternoon workshops as well as Saturday technical sessions. Workshops range from 2-hour to 4-hour slots on Friday afternoon. Technical presentations are each 30-minute timeslots on Saturday. Poster presentations are also welcome.

We are looking for talks related but not limited to the following topics: watershed management, in-lake management, exotic species identification and control, fisheries management and ecology, algal bloom ecology and impacts, lake ecology, and climate change as it relates to lakes.

For abstract submittal, presenters must provide complete information on workshops, presentations and posters they plan to present. Please provide the following information:

- Presenter name, title, and professional affiliation
- Presenter address, telephone, fax, and email.

- Abstract- About 250 words, explaining purpose, approach, results and implications, as appropriate. Please be specific enough to allow independent evaluation of the professional value of the workshop, presentation or poster you plan to present. This will encourage conference attendance when we make the program abstracts available in the form of a preliminary program announcement.
- Presenter biography
