Farmers' Market Rules of Operation

- **Setup: 7am—8am**
- **Sales: 8am—1pm**
- **Booth space available is approximately 10x10, vehicles permitted**
- **Vendors must have required licenses or permits to sell products**
- **Producer only/no resale allowed**
- **Agriculturally-related items permitted (soaps, breads, etc)**
- **Tents recommended but not required**
- **No electricity available**
- **No pets**
- **No smoking**
- **Take down: 1pm—2pm**
