Rules & Regulations for Graduating 4-H Members

The Ashland County Leaders' Association has set aside \$250 scholarships to all graduating 4-H members who meet the requirements listed below. Scholarships of \$250 are available based on applicant(s) qualifications and merit.

Applicant(s):

1. will be mailed a hard copy of the scholarship applications after February 1
2. must have their completed applications in to the Extension Office by April 1
3. will receive their scholarship funds as soon as the applicant(s) submits evidence of being enrolled for the first semester.

Rules & Regulations for Graduating 4-H Members

The Ashland County Leaders' Association has set aside \$250 scholarships to all graduating 4-H members who meet the requirements listed below. Scholarships of \$250 are available based on applicant(s) qualifications and merit.

Applicant(s) must:

1. be a high school senior currently enrolled in the Ashland County 4-H youth program;
2. be an *active* member in good standing for no less than three (3) years and an active Jr. Leader for at least one (1) year;
3. have filled out at least two Member Evaluation (ME) forms prior to their senior year;
4. show sufficient motivation by writing an essay of 500 words (not to exceed 600) answering these questions:
 - ◆ “What is an important concern of youth that you feel 4-H has helped you deal with positively?”
 - ◆ “What has 4-H specifically done to help you develop leadership skills and prepare you for the future?”This essay should be typed and double spaced; grammar and punctuation should be correct. Level and quality of writing skill will be a component.
5. provide the names of three (3) adults (non-related) for references qualified to evaluate the achievement and character of applicant(s). [Applicant(s) will not be considered without references.]
6. give presentation to second grade or above about 4-H with 4-H materials. [Check with Extension Office.]
