Individuals selected for this opportunity will be required to sign a letter of acceptance and financial commitment for this trip in December. Once our county 4-H office submits the number of delegates we'll be sending in December, there is no backing out. The Leaders Association is then responsible for paying for whatever number of delegates we've requested spots for.

The Awards Committee understands that making this commitment 6 or 7 months in advance of the trip may be difficult for some, but the way the program is set up by the State 4-H Office makes it necessary.
