Clark County HCE will be taking a tour to the Wabasha/Kellogg area in Minnesota on **Saturday, October 24.**

Our first stop will be LARK TOYS. Lark Toys is one of the largest independent specialty toy stores in the United States. We will ride the one-of-a-kind, hand-carved wooden carousel. You will be able to select a great game or puzzle or an excellent developmental toy, including toys for special needs. Stock up on arts and crafts supplies, choose a great book or find an ornament for your Christmas tree. Maybe do some Christmas shopping!

Lunch will be at Slippery's, home of the movie "Grumpy Old Men".

After lunch we will visit The Chocolate Escape. Here we will see how chocolates are made, hear about the history and health benefits, and enjoy cocoa tasting and wine pairing. We will smell and taste the differences.
