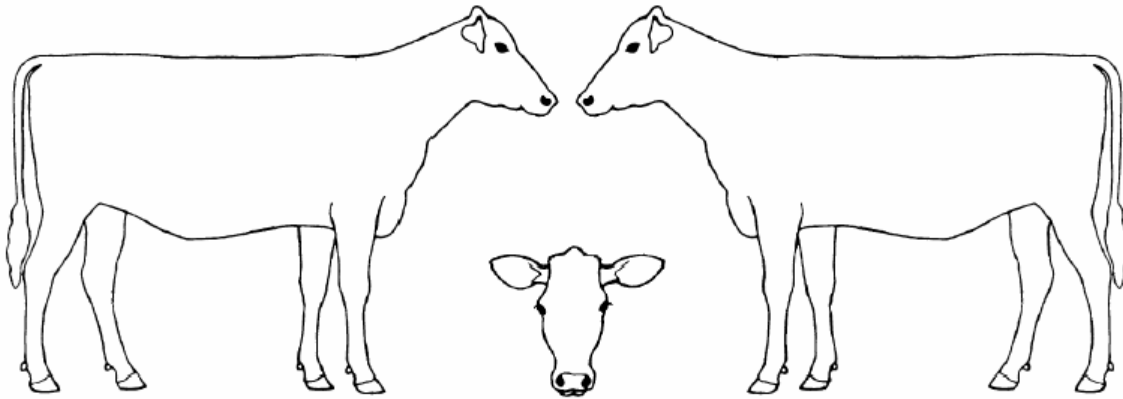

DIRECTIONS FOR IDENTIFYING ANIMALS: Diagram of color markings OR photographs. Either RIGHT side OR LEFT side diagram or photo is acceptable for identification. A tag, tattoo, or freeze brand identifier is necessary when submitting a one-side sketch.

1. **DIAGRAMS:** Diagrams are for spotted breeds only – Holstein, Ayrshire and Guernsey breeds. Outline markings in BLACK INK. Clearly show the color markings of either right OR left side AND the face. For all spotted breeds – Holstein, Guernsey and Ayrshire, outline colored area of animals and place a “W” where the animal is white
2. **PHOTOS:** Photographs may be used for all breeds (Holstein, Ayrshire, Guernsey, Jersey and Brown Swiss). The face, legs, and switch must clearly show on each photograph.

All grade cows on test**must be accompanied by a copy of DHIA test sheet (cows name and test highlighted or circled). Test sheet to accompany this identification sheet and updated test sheet brought to fair on entry day.
