General Photography Fair Guidelines

The printed Fairbook is the source of this information. If there is a conflict in information, the printed Fairbook will be regarded as the authority.

Exhibitor may **ONLY** enter **ONE** class (project enrolled in), **plus** classes D and E.

All pictures must be made within the club year.

Mount picture(s) on 11" x 14" **WHITE** pasteboard using rubber cement--no art corners. (Pasteboard will not be provided).

Pictures may be captioned, but it is not required.

Cropping pictures is acceptable.

A nonadjustable camera is one in which the lens, speed or aperture cannot be changed.

An adjustable camera is one in which the lens, speed or aperture **can** be changed.

"Flash" means flash has an effect on the way the picture turns out.

Only one Merit Award per person in Photography.

Photography 1

7. Adjustable camera - 4 pictures/different subjects - *one each of buildings, people, animals, birds, scenery, or other unique subject* - color.

15. Adjustable camera - 4 black/white pictures processed by exhibitor with a paragraph of information on the methods used.
16. Non adjustable camera - 4 black/white pictures processed by exhibitor with a paragraph of information on the methods used.
