

RULES AND JUDGING PROCEDURE

ELIGIBILITY: All residents of Dodge County and adjoining counties are eligible to participate.

INELIGIBILITY: Food Professional, which includes, but is not limited to: chef, food writer, caterer, dietitian, nutritionist or if you prepare food on a professional basis.

HOW TO ENTER: Send the entry form and your best original recipe using beef cuts or beef products and other products indicated to:

RECIPE JUDGING PROCEDURE

I. Entry Categories:

- A) Kids in the Kitchen (ages 12 & under)
- B) Junior Category (ages 13-18)
- C) Men's Category
- D) Women's Category
- E) Senior's Category (ages 65 & older)

II. Entries must be submitted on the official entry form provided.

III. Entries must be postmarked by **Friday, JULY 18, 2008**. No late entries will be accepted.

IV. Submitted entries will be judged based on this score card:

Taste.....	40%
Ease and Practicality of Preparation.....	35%
Originality.....	15%
Appearance.....	10%

V. All recipes must be original and owned exclusively by the contestant. Previously

published recipes (cookbooks, magazines, etc.) are ineligible.

VI. Recipes will be judged by a panel of judges selected by the Dodge County Beef Cook-Off Committee.

VII. The contest will be held on **Tuesday July 29, 2008 at 6:30 p.m. at the Dodge County Administration Building at 127 E. Oak St. Juneau, WI.**

- Contestants will bring their **finished/cooked** beef product to the contest.

VIII. A winning dish/entry will be chosen from each category. The panel of judges will then select an overall "best" dish.

IX. All decisions and results are final. By participating in this contest you agree to abide by the rules thus said and the decisions of the judges. Rules are subject to change.

OTHER RESTRICTIONS

I. There should be 8 ingredients or less. This does not include salt, regular ground black pepper, cooking spray or water.

II. Each serving must contain at least 3 ounces of cooked, trimmed beef.

III. Ground beef patties must be cooked to medium doneness (160 degrees F) or until center is no longer pink and juices show no pick color

IV. Excluding beef, all other ingredients must not be brand specific.

PRIZES

The winner from each category will receive a prize yet to be announced. Past prizes included: Griddles, Toaster oven, George Foreman Grills, a waffle iron and an egg cooker. All submitted entries will be eligible to be published in the Dodge County Beef Cook-Off Recipe Booklet, which will be made available to the public at the Dodge County Extension Office.
