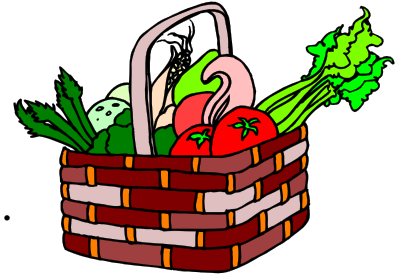


Senior Farmer's Market Vouchers

Dodge County—2009

The Senior Farmer's Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) provides eligible seniors vouchers to use at area farmer's markets and participating roadside stands.



- You must be 60 years of age or older, (or a Native American 55 or older) and reside in Dodge County
- Household income must be at or below 185% of federal poverty level:
 - 1 person: \$1670 monthly / \$20,036 annual income
 - 2 persons: \$2247 monthly / \$26,955 annual income
- Amount is \$25 per household

Vouchers will be distributed on a “first-come, first-served” basis at these places: (# of vouchers proportioned to each site)

- Wednesday, June 10, 10 – 11:30 am: **Mayville Senior Center**, 330 N. Walnut St.
- Tuesday, June 16, 1 – 2:30 pm: **Watertown** meal site, Mueller Apts., 1121 Highland Ave. (take elevator to second floor.)
- Wednesday, June 17, 1:30 – 3 pm: **Beaver Dam Community Action**, 134 S. Spring St.
- Tuesday, June 23, 10 – 11:30 am: **Beaver Dam Senior Center**, 114 East 3rd St.
- Tuesday, June 23, 1 – 3 pm: Dodge Co Admin Bldg, 127 E Oak St, **Juneau**
