HORSE ARENA USAGE POLICY

Since we are getting very close to the beginning of the outdoor riding season at the John Miles County Park Horse Arena, here's the reminder of the new usage policy that was implemented last year:

Individual Usage: If you are planning to use the arena by yourself, or an individual family, you must contact the Parks Department (746-7130) for a waiver form. This form only needs to be filled out once per year, and will cover you for the entire summer.

Group/Club Usage: If your club, project group or other organized group of 4-H members are planning on using the arena, please contact the Extension Office (746-2260) before using the arena so that your group can be put on the calendar. Groups must be signed up in advance! Also, regularly occurring events (i.e.: Drill Team practice, clinics, shows, etc.) need to be on the calendar.

Please be mindful that we need to be cooperative and work with these new rules, and be patient and polite with office staff both in the Extension office and Parks Department office as we work with this new policy!
