HOW TO ENTER ITEMS AT THE FAIR

Are you new to 4-H ... and to exhibiting items at the Door County Fair? Here are some things you need to know about entering at the Fair.

- ✓ **Pre-Registration: EVERYONE** must pre-register their items they plan to enter.
- ✓ **Deadline to register: JULY 2** for all Jr. Fair / 4-H / School Exhibits
- ✓ **Enrollment Forms:** Club General Leaders will have a form for each member. Please call your leader to make arrangements with him/her for pick-up if you miss your club meeting.
- ✓ **Entry Tags:** Tags will be printed for the items you have pre-registered. These tags may be picked up at the Extension Office the week before the Fair, but will NOT be replaced if lost (please call before coming in). They will also be available on Entry Day (Thursday) at the Exhibit office in the Jr. Fair Building. **(Note: Entry Tags will not be given to those who have not returned Booster Buttons and/or money for them.)**
- ✓ **When to Bring Items to the Fair:** Members bring items to the Fair on **Thursday, August 6 (Entry Day)**. Items are judged face-to-face with the judge (a schedule will be in next month's newsletter).
- ✓ **When to take your items home:** Items must stay on exhibit **until Sunday, August 9**. You need to pick them up **between 4 and 6 p.m. -- not before!** If you cannot be there, please send someone with your claim tickets to pick up your items.
- ✓ **More questions?** Contact the Extension Office at 746-2260.

JR. FAIR CLERKS WANTED

Ever wonder how the Door County Fair judges come up with their placing on exhibits? If you would like to find out, how about volunteering to work with a judge at this year's fair. Contact the Extension Office at 746-2260 if you can volunteer some time -- from 1 hour to all day). Your duties as a clerk include:

- Are responsible for the Judging Sheets.
- Should not give input to the judge as items are being judged.
- As 4-Hers bring their items to be judged, find the category and record the placing on the judging sheet - put a check mark next to the exhibitor's name, then circle the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th).
- Open the name flap so everyone can see the exhibitor's name, then put the sticker ribbon on the entry tag.
- Keep items aside that will be considered for special ribbons (i.e. State Fair).
- Record winners on Award Sheet. Please include name, category w/numbers (i.e. Dept. 26, Class A, #1) and a short description of the item.
- Arrange remaining items in cases or on step tables, so everyone can view items without touching.
- After judging is complete, return all judging sheets and supplies to the Exhibit Office.
