<p>_____ <b>Citizenship Washington Focus</b> – Held one week in June or July in Washington, D.C. CWF is a 4-H leadership program for high school youth from across the country. Participants stay at the National 4H Conference Center and take part in a week-long program focused on enriching young people’s lives by providing activities for them which broaden their appreciation and respect for themselves and others in their world. The week consists of participatory workshops, speakers, committee work, field trips and social events.  <u>Qualifications:</u> In grades 10-12.
