Who: 4-H youth (grades 6 and up), 4-H leaders, and photography judges

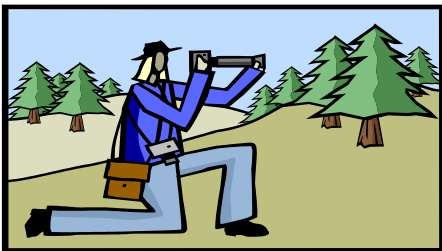
What: This day-long session will include a photo scavenger hunt in the park, so bring your camera (digital if you have one), a USB cable that connects your camera to a computer, laptop if you want and a tripod if you have one. There will be time for sharing and critiquing photos.
