JUNIOR FAIR EXHIBITOR'S DRESS CODE FOR ANIMAL SHOWS AND LIVESTOCK SALE

As street clothes are not show clothes the following will be enforced at the 2008 Dunn County Fair:

- Full length pants (belts are strongly encouraged).
- Shirts must have collars and sleeves. (No halter-tops, tank tops, etc. will be allowed. Bare midriff and/or navel are not to show). Show coats are optional for rabbits, pocket pets and poultry.
- No writing on shirts, including farm names, family names or any advertising.
- Closed toe shoes or boots are required. (No clogs or slides).
- No hats or caps will be allowed.
- Anyone not in compliance with the dress code will be given a chance to change into an outfit that meets the above rules immediately prior to the show. If at any time during a show a member is not in compliance with the dress code he or she will be disqualified from both the show and the sale.
- The superintendents from each department, in combination with the Fair Board will enforce these rules. Plan ahead to have appropriate clothes on show day.
