Wisconsin QUEST Card - The Wisconsin Quest Card (Wisconsin's Electronic Benefits Transfer [EBT] program) allows FoodShare clients to access their benefits through point-of-sale (POS) terminals.

Eligibility & Registration: In Fond du Lac County, call (920) 929-3920, (920)929-3187 or toll-free at 1-800-525-3187 for an appointment to determine eligibility and register. You can also go online to: www.access.wi.gov This website is a quick and easy way for people who live in Wisconsin to see if they are eligible for FoodShare and other Wisconsin health and nutrition programs.

Cost: Basic Package is \$18/month plus shipping and handling charges of \$2.30 for a total of \$20.30
Specialty packages may cost more. Pre-order and prepay to receive food for the following month.
Cash, checks or EBT card accepted.
