ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

1. Each club may submit as many applications as they want. Based on responses, selections will be made and campers notified. Outpost Leadership Team Camp is limited to 20 members.
2. Cost of camp is \$85 if the member completed a record book last year, \$90 if the member did not complete a record book last year. The entire amount must be submitted with each application. This figure includes all costs. This fee would be much higher, if it were not for Finney Implement, Inc. of Lancaster, who is providing an \$8 scholarship and the Grant County 4-H Adult Leaders Association who is picking up a substantial portion of the cost for each member.
3. Checks should be made payable to: Grant County 4-H Fund and mailed to the Extension Office at PO Box 31, Lancaster, WI 53813 by May 15.
4. **Refunds will only be given if the Extension Office is notified ahead of time and an alternate can be found.**
