1. **SCRAPBOOKING (ACTIVE AMERICANS)** - Freeze time by putting your memories on a fun scrapbook page. This is a great way to save your memories for life. Don't know how? We will show you. PLEASE BRING A PICTURE OF YOURSELF for your scrapbook page.
2. **GIFT CARDS (BLOCKHOUSE BUILDERS)** - Have fun creating greeting cards that you can enter in the fairs this summer and have ideas to make more for friends/family.
3. **RECYCLED DRUM (BUSY BADGERS)** - Create a musical instrument while using old plastic containers. Have fun creating a new drum while keeping the environment green.
4. **BUILD A BIRD HOUSE (CASSVILLE RIVERSIDE & WINGS OVER WISCONSIN)** - Help keep your feathered friends warm and cozy as the snow falls with a cute house of their own.
5. **WOODEN PLANTER BOXES (CORNELIA BADGERS)** - Learn how to assemble a planter box while also learning the safety of woodworking.
6. **GALLON PAINT CAN PROJECT (DAIRYLAND DIAMONDS)** - Boys & girls, decorate a gallon paint can as a keepsake can or special occasion gift. Materials will be provided, but if you have something special from home to decorate your can with bring it along.
7. **KEY CHAIN (HAPPY CLOVERS)** - Create a key chain you can use in a variety of ways using colorful beads and different patterns.
8. **FLOWER POT/CANDLE HOLDER (CLEVER CLOVERS)** - Be creative in painting a flower pot or candle holder to keep for a gift or decoration.
9. **DRAWING (LITTLE GRANT)** - Learn some new tricks when drawing. There will be drawing books available to assist you at each session.
10. **TERRARIUMS (MERRY MIXERS)** - Have fun making a low maintenance mini ecosystem in a jar. (limit 10 per session)
11. **COLORED SAND BOTTLES (MT. HOPE CARDINALS)** - Every kid likes to have the chance to play in the sand. Here is your chance to make your own sand art in a bottle. (limit 12 per session)
12. **STRING & WIRE ART PROJECT (PLATTEVILLE WOODCHUCKS)** - Come up with creative art ideas with using string and wire.
13. **FUNKY BEADING (PLUM VALLEY BOOSTERS)** - Time to become funky, use your imagination and design a funky beading design.
14. **WOODEN BIRD FEEDER (STITZER GO-GETTERS)** - Have fun creating a woodworking project while helping out your feathered friends find a place to eat.
15. **IDENTIFICATION BIRD BOOK (STITZER GO-GETTERS)** - Test your knowledge on the different species of birds in your area. Make an identification book that will help you and your friends.
16. **EASTER BASKET & WASHCLOTH BUNNY (WINGVILLE CLOVERS)** - Be ready for the Easter season and create a wonderful paper Easter basket. Also learn how to make a bunny with a washcloth. (limit 8 per session)
17. **QUILTING (WINGVILLE CLOVERS)** - Quilting has been a popular tradition for many years. If you sign up for quilting you will get started on piecing together a potholder! (limit 5 per session, beginner sewers need 2 sessions)
