Enclosed is information about the 2009 Style Revue scheduled for **Saturday, June 27, 2009** at the Government Services Building, Yodel Hall, Pleasant View Complex, Monroe. Registration begins at **9:30 a.m.** Judging will begin at **10:00 a.m. SHARP!!!** Please park behind the building in the **Northwest Parking Lot.** Use the Auditorium Entrance door.

**Here is what you will need to do in order to participate in the Style Revue:**

1. Complete and return the enclosed registration form to University Extension Office, Government Services Building, N3150B Highway 81, Monroe 53566 no later than Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2009. **(No Exceptions)**
2. Be sure to carefully read the information about classes and grades.
3. You must enter in your appropriate grade division for the grade that you were as of January 1, 2009. (Please note: You must exhibit in the same unit in which you are enrolled.)
4. Arrive at the Government Services Building Yodel Hall by **9:30 a.m.** on June 27<sup>th</sup>. Sign in at the Registration Table where you will receive an exhibit number and further instructions.
5. Dressing rooms will be provided.
6. Be ready to line up when your class is called. Your class will be called approximately five minutes before the time of judging. Stay with the others in your class until dismissed.
7. **Honorable Mention Garments**
  - Ages 8-13 year olds (grades 3 – 8) - Judges will select exceptional garments from the blue ribbon winners by placing a sticker on your judging sheet. **Only** these blue ribbon winners will be considered for Honorable Mention.
  - Ages 14 years+ (grades 9+) - Judges will select exceptional garments by placing a sticker on your judging sheet. These winners will be asked to return for selection of State Fair delegates and alternates.

8. Photographs will be taken of all participants, Honorable Mention winners, Junior Honor Court, State Fair delegates, and State Fair alternates. Please go directly to the picture area following your class. A photographer will be taking pictures. To help defray the cost of film and developing, each member will be charged \$2.00 for photos.
9. The classes for costumes and garments made for another individual will be judged first.
10. All State Fair delegates and alternates are required to attend the mandatory State Fair meeting on Thursday, June 25, 2009 @ 7:00 p.m. in the Auditorium.

**Here are some rules you need to know for Style Revue:**

1. No member may enter more than four classes.
2. Garments must be modeled by the person for whom they were made.
3. Garments entered in Style Revue classes may not be entered in Clothing classes at the Green County Fair.
4. Each garment may be entered in one class only.

**Style Revue garments will be judged on the following:**

1. The garment and the member:
  - a) Style of garment
  - b) Becoming color
  - c) Appropriateness of fabric
  - d) Selection of undergarments
  - e) Selection of accessories
  - f) Fit
2. The garment:
  - a) Appropriateness of trimmings
  - b) Selection and quality of construction method
  - c) Present condition of garment
  - d) Upkeep in relation to costume value
3. The member:
  - a) Posture
  - b) Poise
  - c) Overall appearance

All 4-H members are urged to participate in the Style Revue judging and in the Mini Revues at the Green County Fair, which will be held July 22-26, 2009. Be sure to include your clothing revue entries on your fair entry form to receive premium money.
