Things UW-Extension Can Do For *YOU!*

- 1 Our website at www.uwex.edu/ces/city/green is full of information. The site has links to publications and educational websites as well as current calendars listing programs and events of interest to you!
- 2 The Agriculture Agent can assist you with grain, forage and dairy **production management** as well as **research-based production and marketing information** to improve the profitability of your farming enterprise.
- 3 Green County uses a **Program Planning Process** to learn about the educational needs and concerns of county residents like yourself. Once identified, these issues guide our work and make us more locally responsive.
- 4 Participation in 4-H helps Green County youth learn **important life skills** and teaches them how to contribute to their communities through civic involvement and leadership.
- 5 At the **Green County Fair** we work with the Fair Association and hundreds of volunteers in planning and organizing 4-H and FFA exhibits that help give youth in Green County the exposure and recognition they deserve.
- 6 The Family Living Agent can provide you with relevant, research based and age-paced **information on parenting**.
- 7 The Green County UW-Extension Office can provide research-based **assessment, strategic planning and evaluation** to local community organizations that you belong to.
- 8 The Community Resource Development Educator assists your local community groups and governments with **community visioning and planning** processes.
- 9 The Green County UW-Extension Office offers local programs such as the New Rural Landowners Seminar that link you to **research and resources** developed by local USDA agencies and statewide University Specialists.
- 10 The Family Living Agent works with your **local non-profit organizations**, assisting them in improving their organizational effectiveness.
- 11 The Green County UW-Extension Office and the **Sugar/Pecatonica River Basin Educator** can answer questions about stream water quality, stormwater management and groundwater testing.
- 12 Youth can join one of **22 Green County 4-H Community Clubs** where they can participate in over 50 different project areas that suit their individual needs.
- 13 The Green County Extension Office can provide you with the tools and information necessary for **soil testing** in your lawn, garden or field.
- 14 Your UW-Extension office can provide you with **locally tailored statistics** and census data to help with your business idea, grant application, or local policy decision.
- 15 The UW-Extension **Master Gardener Program** trains volunteers who volunteer hours in the community by assisting the UW-Extension office in answering your garden, tree, lawn, shrub and pest questions.
- 16 The Green County UW-Extension Office works with local, state and federal partners to **write grants**, bringing federal and state dollars to your community to support programs such as Clean Sweep, Tractor Safety and the Community Development Block Grant.
- 17 Local policy makers can attend **Family Impact Seminars** that examine the impact of policies or programs on families in Green County.
- 18 **Pesticide Applicator training sessions** are held for Green County Farmers so they can be certified and trained in the safe and proper use of restricted-use chemicals.
- 19 The 4-H & Youth Development Agent can help your community group build **effective youth/adult partnerships**.
- 20 UW-Extension works with local partners to design and conduct **research and surveys** that inform local decisions.
- 21 The Green County UW-Extension Office links you to the resources of the **Southwest Wisconsin Small Business Development Center** that provides no cost individual business counseling and specialized trainings to help you get started in business or to help your existing business be more successful.
- 22 The Green County UW-Extension Office can answer your questions about **food preservation and food safety**.
- 23 You can practice leadership skills, deepen your understanding of community issues, and prepare for leadership roles by participating in **Green County Leaders**, a countywide leadership program the Community Resource Development Agent works with.
- 24 Using **WisLine teleconferencing technology**, the Green County UW-Extension Office brings you timely programs offered across the state on topics such as local governance and finance.
