The Tri-County Leadership Initiative (TCLI) is designed to meet the local demand for community leaders. TCLI is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create opportunities for participants to increase their knowledge, skills and confidence; develop insight and become involved leaders in their communities. TCLI offers individuals in Green Lake, Marquette and Waushara counties the opportunity to change their lives and the lives of those in the area around them.

TCLI's intense, comprehensive course will:

- ⇒ Equip participants with the skills to make a difference in their communities;
- ⇒ Engage participants in their community;
- ⇒ Provide the opportunity for personal and professional growth;
- ⇒ Develop civic responsibility and;
- ⇒ Encourage collaboration between local government, community and private investment.

In partnership with the University of Wisconsin Extension, participants meet weekly, from October through mid November. Graduation will be held in the summer, after completion of a class project.

Each session will provide the opportunity for personal and professional growth. Participants will meet and interact with leaders from the region who will present concrete information about issues of local concern.

The curriculum for the program includes:
