Iowa County has adopted ordinances giving general zoning authority in all of the unincorporated area of the county, including within areas of floodplain, shoreland and wetlands. Any proposed development (new or replacement) should first be discussed with the Office of Planning and Development prior to ensure compliance to any relevant ordinance provision. After presenting the proposal to the county, it may be necessary to discuss the proposed development with the town or towns affected, as most towns have adopted comprehensive plans. The Office of Planning and Development has always preferred compliance over citations, so please DO NOT commit to contracts or expend funds until all required county and town permits have been secured. In the case of a violation, it is the property owner who is responsible, regardless of what a contract with a builder may say.

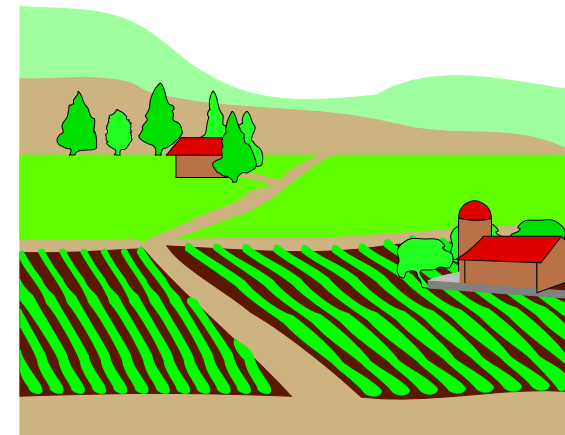
