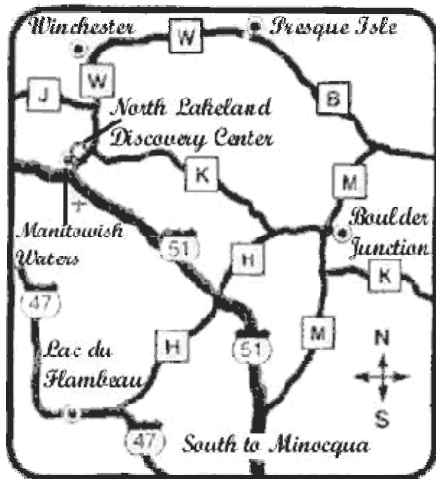


## North Lakeland Discovery Center

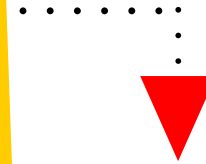

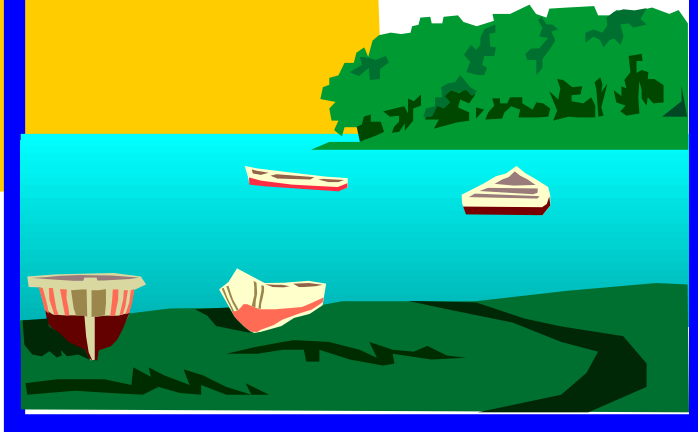

# Iron County Summer Youth Camp

2008 - The eighth annual Iron County Summer Youth Camp is planned for July 8-11 at the North Lakeland Discovery Center in Manitowish Waters. This camp is open to Iron County youth who are presently in the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades. The camp will be fun, safe, educational and packed full of memories that can last a lifetime.



## Dear Campers and Parents,

We are happy you are interested in the Iron County Summer Youth Camp. We have been planning for this year's camp and know you will have fun, meet new friends and enjoy the activities.

We have less than 100 beds for camp staff and for campers. We will fill the male and female cabins as first come/first served so please return the COMPLETED registration form with your camp deposit or total fees to reserve a bed. The number of campers also depends upon the number of counselors who sign up. We need to have appropriate ratios of campers to counselors and adults.

Our camper fee of \$50 is staying the same as the last 4 years. We are providing optional round trip transportation for a \$20 fee because 1) It is a service to parents and 2) Campers make an easier transition when arriving to camp as a group. We have struggled to keep the fees affordable when we know that a four day camp charges, on average, \$360 in Wisconsin. Our community sponsors keep the camp fees as low as possible.

The total expenses for camp are over \$11,000. This includes \$4200 facility rental, food \$3000, Camp T-Shirts \$950, Transportation \$1000, stipends for a cook & lifeguard \$750, canoe instruction & outfitting \$600, camp staff training \$550 and medical & activity supplies \$300. Camp expenses are covered by your registration fees and by about \$7,000 in donations from individuals, businesses and community organizations.

YOU CAN HELP keep fees low by finding a new camp sponsor. A camp donation brochure is enclosed for you to pass along to a group, individual or business that might help. We always need new sponsors and THANK YOU for your help.
